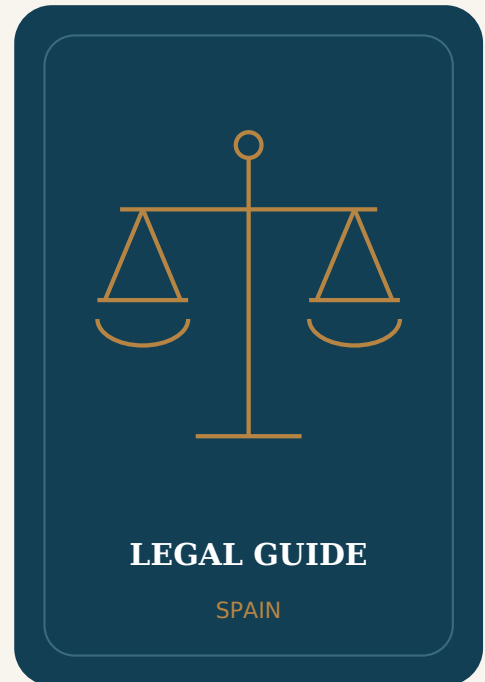

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HOW THE PROCESS USUALLY WORKS

1. Initial review

Clarify your objectives, timeline and the main legal issue.

2. Document assessment

Review the paperwork and identify any gaps or risks.

3

3. Strategy and action

Agree practical next steps and the most suitable route.

4

4. Follow-through

Support implementation, communication and final formalities.

A clear chronology and complete documents usually make legal advice faster and more precise.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS

Children first

Child-focused planning is often central to residence, contact and decision-making issues.

Financial picture

Assets, income, housing and ongoing expenses should be reviewed early.

Communication

Measured communication and realistic objectives can reduce conflict and costs.

Interim needs

Urgent practical arrangements may be needed while a longer-term agreement is negotiated.

Is an amicable agreement always possible?

Sometimes, but it depends on the level of cooperation and the complexity of the issues.

Not always. In some cases negotiation or mediation can be explored first.

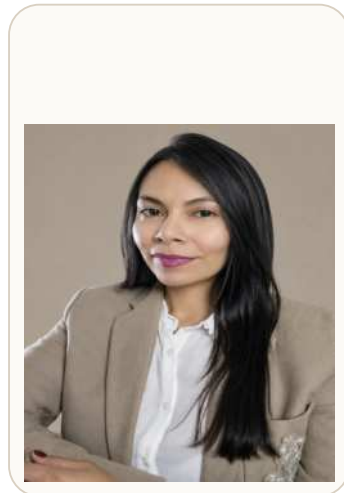
What if urgent arrangements are needed?
