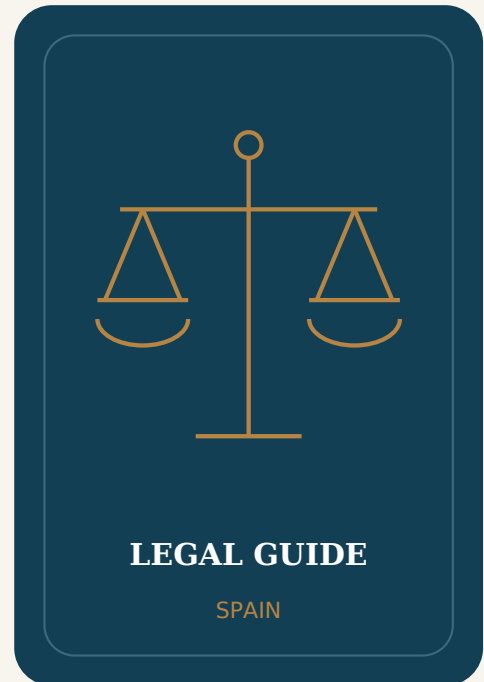

1. Initial review

Clarify your objectives, timeline and the main legal issue.

2

2. Document assessment

Review the paperwork and identify any gaps or risks.

3

3. Strategy and action

Agree practical next steps and the most suitable route.

4

4. Follow-through

Support implementation, communication and final formalities.

A clear chronology and complete documents usually make legal advice faster and more precise.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS

Estate structure

Nationality, residence, assets and family circumstances all shape the best succession plan.

Cross-border issues

Different countries may interact on applicable law, probate steps and tax questions.

Formal documents

Death certificates, wills, family records and property or banking documents are commonly required.

That depends on several factors including nationality, residence and elections of law.

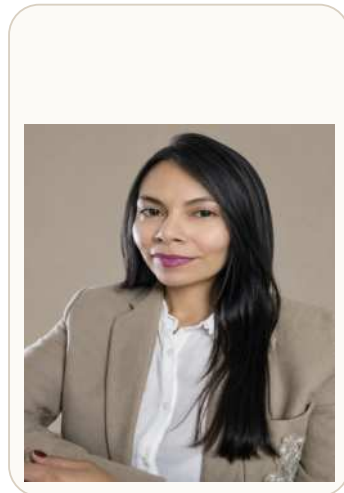
Can planning reduce administrative difficulties?
